

1. Know Yourself

- Don't lose sight of purpose
- Be honest and objective
- Be realistic
- What will make you happy?
- It's okay for preferences to change



2. Learn About College Baseball & Recruiting Process

- 1st 2 action steps in KPB's Process
- 1600+ college baseball programs
- Work from wide to narrow
- Bust myths (exposure, scams, etc.)
- Knowledge = Power and Leverage



3. Create a Personal Recruiting Plan

Given...

- Honest view of self and college baseball goals
- Understanding of opportunities and knowledge of process

What is going to give YOU best chance at reaching goals?

- Specific > General
- Ownership: This is your career!



4. Control the Controllables

- Executing your plan
- Keep internal focus
- Focus on what you control
- Avoid comparisons to peers
- Stay off emotional rollercoaster
- You are going to crush this!


5 Roles For Parents

- 5. Be a good teammate


